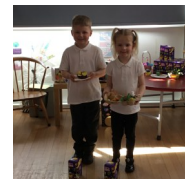

PE Kits

Please ensure that your child has a suitable PE kit available in school at all times.

-They will require both an **indoor** and **outdoor** kit.

A pair of pumps or trainers **MUST** be worn for outdoor PE.

-We advise your child brings their kit on a Monday and takes it home to wash on Fridays.



School Premises

Dogs -Can we please remind you that as a school there is strictly **NO DOGS** allowed on school premises at any time, this also includes dogs being carried by their owners.

Bikes/Scooters -Please can you ensure your child dismounts as they enter the school gates and walk their scooter/bike to the shelter. Electric scooters cannot be ridden on roads and pavements, or in public spaces such as parks by law. This includes school premises.

Car park - Can we please ask that parents/ carers do not use or walk through the school car park and children do not enter the car park at any time. This is for the Children's safety.

Parking - Please be mindful of where you park and try to avoid blocking the pavements in the local area.

No Smoking or Vaping - Smoking or vaping is not permitted on school grounds.
