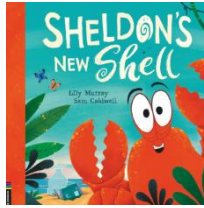
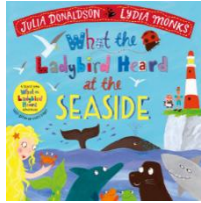
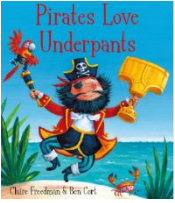


Literacy
